Investment in Camps Valley – April 26

Welcome to our newsletter updating you on Scottish Waters work at Camps Reservoir.

Programme & Progress Update – work on the spillway is complete. The reservoir was allowed to fill and its capabilities have been tested to prove it operates as it should. The low reservoir level no longer requires to be managed by our operations team for the project.

Our teams focus on site over the last few months has been to remove plant and equipment, no longer required, such as the batching plant. The excess stone used to create the ramp up to the spillway has been removed from the dam face and is expected to remain on site for future operational requirements. We have an agreement in principle with the appropriate landowner to store this at a secure location near the reservoir.

More recently, the reinstatement of the dam face has begun. This consists of regrading the land to match the existing slope, installing a Geocell subbase to mitigate erosion, infill with new topsoil and then finally hydroseeding.

We expect the grass from the hydroseeding to begin to show before the end of May. This area will remain fenced off to allow the roots to establish and the grass time to grow.

Next steps – the current compound will be deconstructed, and from the first week in May, a smaller compound will be re-established at the previous hard standing location near the neighbouring properties. This will then allow us to remove temporary works such as the bridge over the scour channel.

A smaller presence is expected to remain on site over the summer months to finish metal works within the spillway, and to complete any final reinstatements.

We would like to thank the community for your continued cooperation and understanding while this essential work is ongoing. You can keep track of progress via our webpage, and we will issue another newsletter **Summer 2026**.
