Taking care of your sewer network in Clarkston

We wrote to you recently regarding planned works in your area and would now like to give you a further up date.

What we are doing

We are taking care of your wastewater services in your community which will help prevent sewer flooding and to do this we need to upgrade the sewer network in your area.

When are we doing it

The site compound at Moray Gardens has now been successfully established, and the water main diversion works commenced on 10th June 2026 at Moray Drive. Construction of the new sewer line is scheduled to fully commence in August on Moray Drive, progressing thereafter into Stamperland Gardens. The overall programme remains on track, with completion still expected within 12 months.

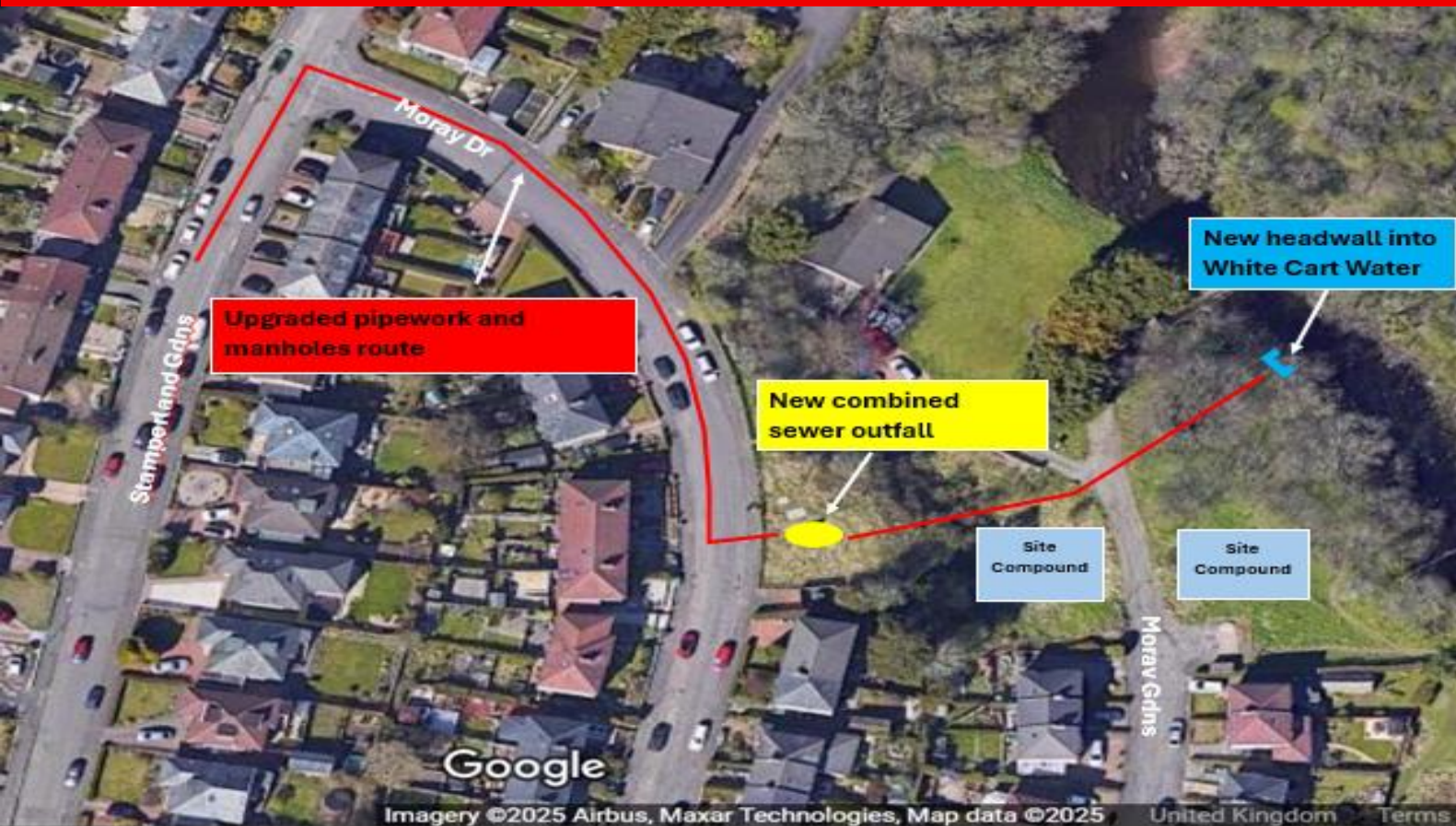
What happens next

- Please see over the page for site layout along with pipeline route.
- To facilitate the installation of the new wastewater pipeline, it has been necessary to close Moray Drive. This work was initially planned to be carried out in phases, however, to minimize overall disruption particularly in relation to noise associated with excavating it was decided to undertake the works in a single section during the watermain diversion. Moray Drive will therefore remain closed for the duration of remaining works, with completion of the sewer pipeline currently anticipated in December 2026.
- Work on Stamperland Gardens will be carried out under traffic lights, starting in January 2027
- You will see and hear an increase in construction traffic and noise during the project our site team will endeavor to keep the level of noise and disruption to a minimum.
