What we are doing

We are upgrading the wastewater system in your area to help manage heavy rainfall, protect your community from flooding and improve the water environment. We will construct a replacement Storm Overflow (SO) to house a powered screen within the grass area surrounding Grangepans Pumping Station with some local sewer re-alignment work.

When are we doing it

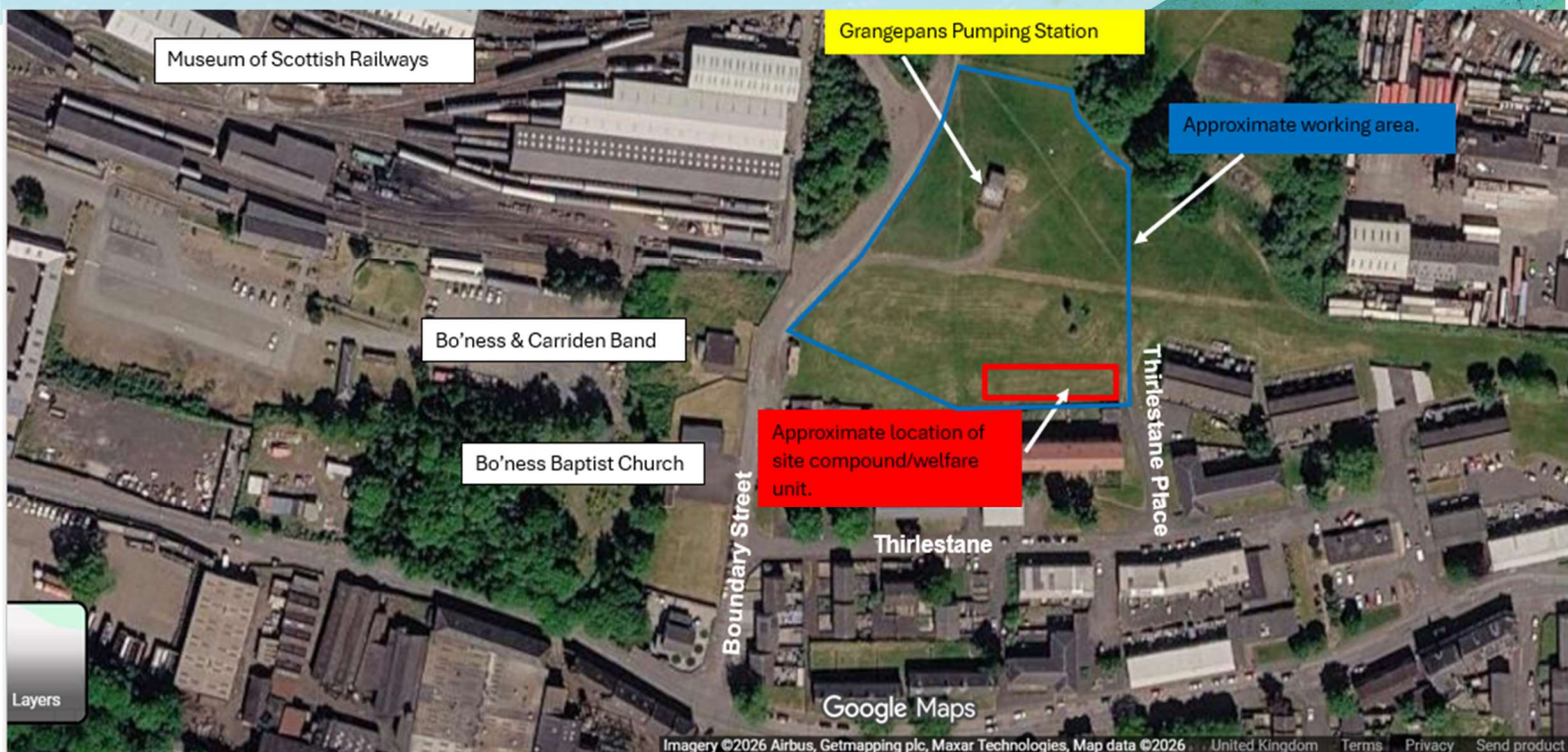
Work is planned to start from Monday 10th August 2026. We will begin site set up for approx. 2weeks prior to the main work starting. The full programme of work is expected to be completed within approx. 8 months.

What happens next

- **Details of the works location can be found over page.**
- Working areas will be fenced off to ensure safety of the workforce and members of the public.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained where possible. Please take care and follow any signs in place.
- There will be some disruption from construction traffic and noise during the works. We will do all we can to keep this to a minimum.
