Improving Urban Waters in Kirkcaldy.

What we are doing

We are upgrading the waste water system in your area to help manage heavy rainfall, protect your community from flooding and improve the water environment. We will construct a replacement Storm Overflow (SO) to house a powered screen within Ravenscraig car park with some local sewer re-alignment work. This work will involve a section of Dysart Road being closed and a small number of parking spaces within Ravenscraig car park suspended. (See map overleaf).

When are we doing it

Work is planned to start from Monday 23rd February 2026. This programme of work is expected to be completed late autumn 2026.

What happens next

- **Details of the road closure/parking restrictions can be found over page.**
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Local access to private driveway's will be maintained where possible. Should there be any time where access needs to be restricted our site team will liaise with individual customers directly. There may be restrictions with on street parking.
- **There will be no planned disruption to your water or waste services during our work.**
- We will do all we can to keep disruption to a minimum.



Area of Road Closure

- Dysart Road will be closed from the junction with The Kyles to just past Ravenscraig Park Car Park (Red Area)
- There will be no vehicle access to and from both Ravenscraig Street and Harriett Street onto Dysart Road.
- Pedestrian Access will be maintained
- Local Diversion will be in place and signed
- Driveways will be maintained, however there may be some onstreet parking restrictions in place.



Ravenscraig Park Car Park – Access

- Vehicle access to Ravenscraig Park Car Park will be maintained from the East via Dysart Road (Yellow Arrow).
- No vehicle access will be available from the West.
