# Taking care of your sewer network in Perth Road, Dundee.

## What we are doing.

We are taking care of the wastewater services in your community by carrying out reactive repairs to the sewer network. This work is required to maintain your essential sewer services.

## When are we doing it.

**Work will start on Perth Road, Dundee on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2026 and is expected to last a minimum of 5 weeks. A road closure is required for the duration of our work.**

## What happens next.

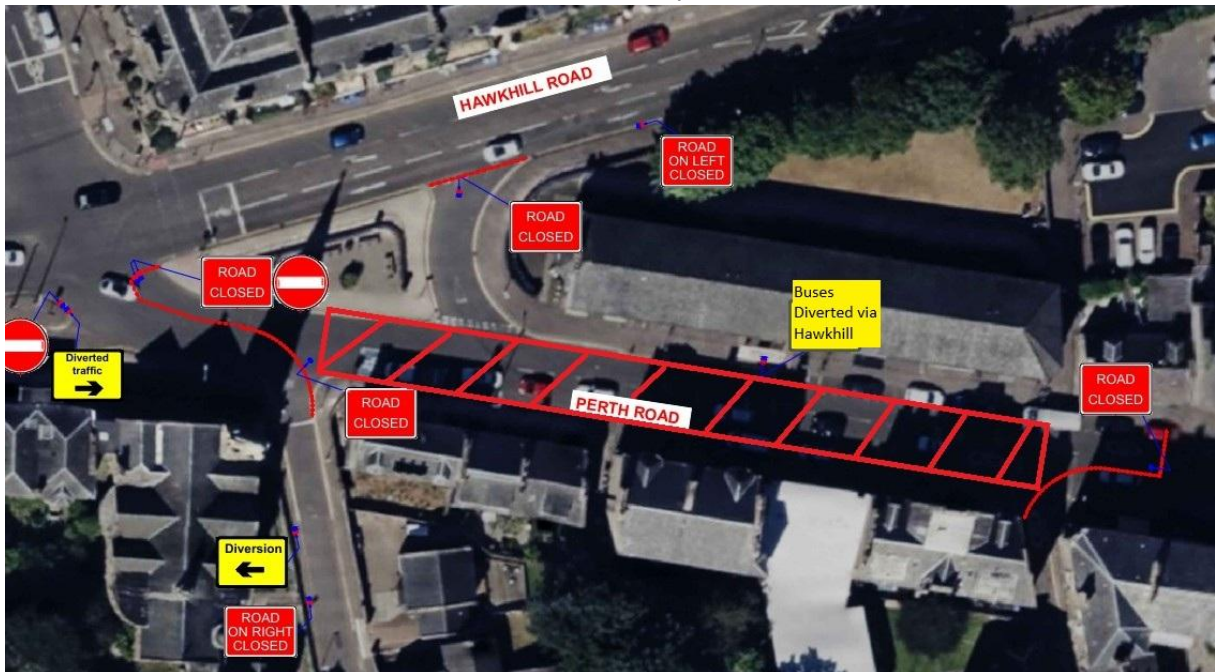
- We need to safely repair and upgrade a collapsed section of sewer on Perth Road. This will ensure the wastewater network continues to operate reliably now and in the future.
- *See Overleaf:* **Perth Road, between the junctions of Shepherds Loan and Taylors Lane, will be closed to any through traffic for the duration of our work. No vehicles will be permitted within this area.** Only emergency vehicles may be permitted access.
- Footpaths on either side of the road will remain open to allow pedestrians access to residential and business premises. Bins should be taken out as usual.
- **All buses services will be diverted via Hawkhill.** Road users should take care while following all diversion signage and allow extra time for journeys through this area.

- Your water supply and drainage services from your kitchen and bathroom will not be affected by our work.
- Our early assessment of the required repairs has offered that it may take at least 5 weeks to complete this work. However, this duration will be dictated by what we uncover once we begin to excavate the ground.
- **During our work you may notice some noise from plant and equipment, including the use of over-pumping that may operate overnight. We will do our best to mitigate any disruption where possible.**
- Once the work is complete, all areas occupied as part of our operations will be fully reinstated.
